Our program utilises Cricket Australia's guidelines for player and umpire development and offers progressive development as students move through the years at Butler College.

Our dynamic teaching staff are high-level performers with Level 2 cricket coaching accreditations, as well as a wealth of local and international experience as players and coaches. Utilising this expertise, students are skilled and conditioned in current methodology, techniques and qualifications.

Those students who are successful with their application and are invited to participate, must maintain academic standards and comply with College policies and behavioural guidelines throughout their involvement in the Program. Students who are unable to comply with these standards will be removed from the Program.

The Program is open to both male and female students in Years 7 & 8 in 2018, at a cost of \$150 per year. All costs are compulsory charges, necessary to cover our commitment to external providers for the Program.

Applicants must be enrolled at Butler College (meeting all the requirements of the enrolment application process) and attend Butler College fulltime, with this program operating as a double elective unit in both Semesters of each year. Students will receive professional coaching and play regular matches in Terms 1 and 4, and will have the opportunity to participate in interstate and overseas tours as they progress through the years at Butler College.
